**OFFICE ORDER**

Subject: Removal of Vikram Hospital from list of empanelled hospitals under CGHS Bengaluru

A Show Cause notice was issued to Vikram Hospital for violating the terms of contract (non providing of Credit Facilities and over charging in excess of CGHS rates ) vide Letter **F. No.19-3/1/2014-Admn/6642 dated 22/12/2017**. The reply given vide **Letter dated 23/12/2017** has been examined and is found to be unsatisfactory. An interim decision to recover the excess amount charged from pending hospital bills of Vikram Hospital, pending disciplinary action was taken vide **Letter F. No.19-3/1/2014-Admn/4267 dated 25/07/2018**. However few more complaints from beneficiaries have been received for not providing credit facilities and thus repeated violation of terms of contract.

In view of above **Vikram Hospital, #71/1, Millers Road, Opp. St. Anne's College, Bengaluru-560052** is de-empanelled from the list of empanelled hospitals under CGHS Bengaluru with effect from **25/09/2018**.
